When Elizabeth Lawrence's family comes to visit, they occasionally bring something that once belonged to their famous aunt. On May 19, they brought a figurative and literal treasure trove. I could not believe how many things came back "home": two wrought iron bridge lamps, by which Elizabeth no doubt spent countless hours reading in her living room; a couple of wool blankets that surely kept her warm on chilly late nights as she wrote in her studio; a bamboo alto recorder from the 1930s that she played with "The Pipers" in Raleigh; and—the group of items that nearly brought me to tears—her original gardening tools.

Right after we retrieved all of the riches from the back of their minivan, Elizabeth's family had to get back on the road. As they were leaving, Elizabeth's niece-in-law, Fran, turned to me and said, "We're thrilled to think of you using Aunt's tools in the garden again!" It would have been unthinkable (not to mention absurdly rude) to blurt out what was whizzing around my mind, which was something along the lines of, "Are you NUTS?! NO WAY am I gonna use these tools; they're

priceless!!" Thankfully, my mental filter was intact in that moment, and, still starstruck by these banal yet amazing objects, I replied with a distracted smile, "Yeeaaah." I may have had the presence of mind to add something about keeping them inside, but I kind of doubt it; I was simply blown away. The rest of the afternoon was spent getting to know the new (old) additions to the house.

WING HAVEN SELECTED FOR PRESERVATION PROGRAM

Wing Haven is proud to announce that last fall, it was one of 56 institutions in the United States selected to participate in the Collections Assessment for Preservation (CAP) program.

CAP helps organizations improve the care of their collections by providing support for a general conservation assessment of the site's collections and buildings. Throughout the process, Wing Haven staff and volunteers worked with a team of preservation professionals to identify preventive conservation priorities. The final assessment

report will help Wing Haven prioritize its collections care efforts in the coming years.

"Receiving this grant and completing this report is part of Wing Haven's long-term strategy to help us establish a master maintenance and preservation plan for the two historic gardens of Wing Haven—Wing Haven Garden & Bird Sanctuary and the Elizabeth Lawrence House & Garden," said Executive Director Barrett Ranson Shannonhouse.

BIRDING: CONTINUING ELIZABETH CLARKSON'S LEGACY

Elizabeth Clarkson was an avid bird-watcher and a life-long student of ornithology. She wrote a book entitled *Birds of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County*, co-sponsored the founding of the Mecklenburg County Chapter of the Audubon Society, and protested against the use of DDT in Charlotte—a pesticide she correctly insisted harmed the birds. Elizabeth also corresponded with renowned ornithologists and was well known in the birding community on a national level. Elizabeth kept a record of all the birds she saw in her garden in her birding journal which can be found on Wing Haven's website.

Today, we continue to educate and encourage the public to learn more about our local birds. One way we do this is through our programming. Here are some of the birding inspired programs we have done in the past year and that we host on a regular basis:

- From October through May, we offer a Bird Walk on the second Monday of the month.
- Come hone your citizen scientist muscles at our annual participation in the *Great Backyard Bird Count*.
- Over 140 campers at Camp Wing Haven learned about birds and birding from Mecklenburg Audubon Society volunteers this summer.

- Last year we were fortunate enough to virtually host Curtis Smalling, Conservation Director at the North Carolina Audubon Society during our annual lecture series. Curtis presented on two lecture topics, *The Birds in our Lives and How They Live Theirs* and *Know Your Nests*. These informative lectures are available for purchase on our website.
- With help from the Mecklenburg County chapter of the Audubon Society, we were a host site for the 2022 National Audubon Photography Awards Traveling Exhibition.
- Last spring we offered an adult workshop on Birding
 Basics. Next February we will host an adult workshop on
 Backyard Birds.

A HAVEN FOR HEALING

Gardens have a long history of providing healing and a place of sanctuary for animals and people alike.

The origins of therapeutic gardens date all the way back to ancient Egypt, where royals were often prescribed "garden walks" for their maladies. After WWI and WWII, veterans were often placed in occupation therapy or mental health care programs that took place in greenhouses and gardens. This environment allowed veterans to disconnect from certain traumas of war through the perceived sense of safety and the welcomed distractions found in the garden.

Today, we have a term for this experience of healing found when we pass through the garden's gates—therapeutic horticulture.

In many ways, Wing Haven is founded on the idea of therapeutic horticulture and the restorative power of gardens. Elizabeth Clarkson, while recuperating from undulant fever, spent time outside on a cot that Eddie had set up for her. During this time, she discovered her love for birds and found healing in nature. She experienced the effects of passive therapeutic horticulture.

While the essence of this practice has been around for ages, therapeutic horticulture (and the more structured horticultural therapy) is actively emerging in the medical mainstream as a proven treatment modality for a wide variety of illnesses and disabilities. More and more people are visiting the gardens to find healing, and there's research to prove that it's working. Consider these benefits:

• In a garden we can reconnect to nature and its ephemeral beauty. With each passing bloom and subsequent decay, we are able to identify the transition of time into a new season. There are ample opportunities for memory recall through this strong orientation to time and the seasons, particularly in those suffering from memory and cognition impairments, Alzheimer's disease, dementia, etc.

- · Working in a garden gives the opportunity to regain strength after an injury or illness. We can build fine and gross motor skills planting seeds of varying sizes or regain hand strength with the use of pruning shears.
- Time spent in a garden can also help to improve our social and emotional health, be it through reconnecting with loved ones on a walk or making new connections while volunteering. We can find remedies for social isolation and loneliness in a garden.

"You never know who will need the garden the most."

Elizabeth and Eddie knew when they named their garden that its intention and design would always be that which is defined in its title —to serve as a haven, or a place of safety or refuge. While we know their dream was originally intended for birds and wildlife, they must have known humans would undoubtedly benefit from its sense of safety and retreat as well.

The Clarkson's welcomed guests into their garden every day and rarely turned away a visitor who wanted to come inside. Elizabeth once said, "You never know who will need the garden the most." She understood, maybe through her own experience in the garden, that there was meaning and value to time spent inside the garden's walls.

When we carry on the legacy of Elizabeth Clarkson and Elizabeth Lawrence's gardens, we also carry on an important legacy of compassion and healing for wildlife and for ourselves.

The lamps immediately went back to their original spots on either side of the fireplace. The wool blankets originally lived on a daybed in Elizabeth's studio. In the absence of a daybed, they were draped over the backs of two armchairs in the living room. The soft colors and texture add warmth and intimacy to the space. I have yet to find the perfect place or method to display the alto recorder, so it is stored away with other recorders that once belonged to Elizabeth. As for the gardening tools, for now, they are on display in the studio, leaning against a closet door.

I am still struck by the decades of wear on the wood handles of the forged iron loppers. (Yes, you read that right—forged iron loppers.) The rounded yet somehow still sharp points of the business-end of the hand weeder tell me it has seen some quality time in the garden. There is also an iron rake, a long-handled four-prong cultivator, and a two-prong weeder hoe. These tools are sturdy. They were built to last a lifetime, if not longer. Their presence in this space silently bridges the worlds of the writer with the gardener, the inside with the outside, the past with the present.

To think that Elizabeth Lawrence—our Elizabeth Lawrence, who is listed among the top 25 gardeners of all time—used these tools to cultivate the ground of this one-third acre lot that inspired so much of her writings, for which she is internationally celebrated and revered... that's as close to having her appear in the flesh as I can imagine. (Thoughts like that make me want to put everything she owned in display cases as secure as the popemobile.)

Thanks to a dedicated team of volunteer host/interpreters, visitors are invited to tour the house most Thursday, Friday and Saturday afternoons. In addition to introducing visitors to Elizabeth Lawrence, her life and life's work, host/interpreters share stories behind these items—and many others—that Elizabeth's family has brought back "home". The opportunity to share more of Elizabeth Lawrence, her life and life's work is so impactful, and further deepens the understanding of the significance of one of this country's greatest writers of garden literature.





WING HAVEN'S COLLECTIONS INCLUDE...



(Above) Archive Collections include documents, like these stored in archival cases of records, correspondence and photos kept by Lindie Wilson during her tenure at the Elizabeth Lawrence House & Garden. Elizabeth Clarkson's sewing room now serves as the storage room for the Clarkson's archival records.

(Far top right) Our Living Collections consist of all types of plants; from structural plantings such as the Willow Oak in the White Rose Garden of Wing Haven Garden & Bird Sanctuary to the smallest of bulbs like the Galanthus elwesii (Elwes's snowdrop) which Elizabeth Lawrence planted in her garden in the fall of 1964.

(Far bottom right) Other Collections include original statuary like St. Fiacre which Elizabeth Clarkson placed as the focal point when looking out their dining room window at the Oval Pool. Among this collection at the Elizabeth Lawrence House & Garden is a Victorian Era swinging bench that Elizabeth brought from her Raleigh garden.

The Society of American Archivists defines archives as noncurrent records of individuals, groups, institutions, and governments that contain information of enduring value. Archival records are:

- From primary sources
- Created by individuals, groups, and institutions in the course of their work
- Often unpublished and not intended for publication
- Raw and uninterpreted
- Selected for preservation due to their historical association and/or the usefulness or significance of the information contained therein

For our two historic properties, this includes:

- Manuscripts/writings
- Correspondence
- Photos
- Drawings
- Scrapbooks
- Clippings
- Lists
- Orders, invoices and receipts

For the Wing Haven Foundation, this includes:

- Founding documents
- Records
- · Deeds of ownership

The CAP award to Wing Haven includes \$7,200 for consultation and site visits from skilled assessors and results in a comprehensive report that outlines recommendations for improving collections care and building preservation. The CAP program is administered by the Foundation for Advancement in Conservation through a cooperative agreement with the Institute of Museum and Library Services. The Foundation for Advancement in Conservation's mission is to save cultural heritage for future generations, protecting it from decay and destruction.

Limited to museums and historical properties, CAP assessments offer a study of all the institution's collections, buildings, and building systems, as well as its policies and procedures relating to collections care.

Over the course of a year, throughout the application and award process, Wing Haven researched and collected data, answered detailed questionnaires, formed a committee of staff and volunteers for planning and advice, and hosted a three-day site visit by collections and building assessors. The assessors together examined the Clarkson and Lawrence historic homes and gardens, living and nonliving collections, and reviewed organization policies and practices.

The final CAP assessment assists by:

- Providing recommendations and priorities for collections care specific to Wing Haven's collections
- Facilitating the development of a long-range preservation plan or conservation plan
- Serving as a case statement for future collections projects

The 139-page CAP report and findings will help Wing Haven to prioritize, plan and budget for work that supports projects that safely preserve historic records and buildings, make records more available to the public and allow for future scholarship, enhance visitor experience, safety and accessibility, and inform future interpretation and programming.

With help from Wing Haven Foundation Endowment and Legacy Campaign donors, we will work with partners and grantors over the coming years to accomplish the priorities as outlined in the CAP report and subsequent conservation plan. For example, restoration work on the Lawrence (c. 1948) and Clarkson homes (c. 1927), physical and digital collections care, and more.

In spring of 2024, we will have a second opportunity to consult with the assessors to report on progress, request further advice, and address any challenges that may have arisen.

A living collection is a group of plants grown for a defined purpose, including for reference, research, conservation, education or ornamental display. This includes:

- · All original/historic and significant plantings
- Plantings that contribute to the original intent/mission of each of our properties:
- ➡ Wing Haven Garden & Bird Sanctuary
- ➡ Elizabeth Lawrence House & Garden
- ⇒ SEED Wildlife & Children's Garden

OTHER COLLECTIONS

We have other first source items that originated with our historic properties that require conservation and preservation.

Other garden collections include all original:

- Built garden features (including walls, paths and stone work)
- Water features (including fountains, pools, spigots and bird baths)
- Ornamentation and statuary (including gates, sun dials, plaques and decorative finials)

Other interior collections include:

- Original furniture
- Books
- Decorative furnishings
- Textiles
- Various personal effects (including garden tools)
- Musical instruments


